- Track Side Operations

#1 First Aid Post & Isolation Tent

- Masks to be worn by ALL visitors, Doctor and First Aid Post Team
- Handwash station placed outside at entrance with soap dispensers and tissue
- 3. Antibacterial accessible and monitor supply at door and in waiting area
- 4. Medical Records secured
- COVID19 MOHW Flyers and Educational posters
- Write staff policy for mandatory wearing of masks and incorporate mask/breathing breaks
- Staff Policy for age limits, preexisting conditions – regular checks, request medical reports
- 8. Assist in contact tracing
- 9. Handle all referrals for illness
- 10. COVID19 Train the Trainer
- 11. Contact with MOHW/Hospitals
- 12. Contact with STH/KPH
- 13. AC service contract and ventilate

#2 TRACK (Sterile Area)

- 1. No unauthorized person
- Staff and Jockeys MUST WEAR MASKS in Track area, transfer locations, legging up, etc. (train teams for mask/breathing breaks – more than 6ft from others)
- Jockey's mask is OPTIONAL

 during Training and race while on the track
- 4. Grooms to wear masks always from when they leave the stable and until they return to the stable
- 5. Place public wash station nearby Track for after start clean up
- Anti-bacterial dispensers in area, Track side Security to have alcohol spray bottles
- 7. Signs
- 8. Review movement pattern to minimize risk of crowding
- 9. Choose horses wisely for Day 1





Stables (Entrance and Inside)

- 1. No unauthorized persons
- Staff MUST WEAR
 MASKS when physical
 distancing less than 6 ft
- 3. Soap Dispensers at wash stations
- 4. Anti-bacterial dispensers at entrance
- 5. Signs
- Upgrade house-keeping rules – keep neat
- 7. Waste disposal stable waste (skips) and garbage (bins/skips)
- Trainers: Maintain Staff
 Records for Contact
 Tracing, Set illness
 Policy, COVID19
 Engagement and
 Training for Grooms







Pool (Horses Only),

- No unauthorized persons in area
- 2. Staff MUST WEAR MASKS when physical distancing less than 6 ft (e.g. more than 4 persons at the pool area)
- 3. Address housekeeping rules – clean, keep neat and review waste disposal at site
- 4. Disinfect Pool gates, equipment and supplies daily
- 5. Signs
- 6. Train Grooms in handwash hygiene (after swimming session back at the stable)







Grooms' Recreation Hall

- No unauthorized persons
 Hall capacity limited to
 inside and 10 outside
- 2. No crowding anywhere
- Grooms MUST WEAR MASKS always inside and outside of Hall
- 4. Doors/windows open and domino table outside
- 5. Handwash station and Soap Dispensers at entrance with tissue
- 6. Anti-bacterial dispensers at entrance
- MOHW COVID19
 Signs/brochures and training
- Upgrade house-keeping rules – clean, keep neat and review waste disposal
- 9. Clean and disinfect twice daily (8.25% bleach)





VETS Office, Training Room and Training Bus for Jockey Interns (Seasonal)

- No unauthorized persons
- Staff MUST WEAR MASKS when physical distancing less than 6 ft and in training room
- Mask/Breathing breaks during training
- Anti-bacterial dispensers at entrance and in the Training room and office
- Temperature checks before entering Training room and offices
- MOHW COVID19 Signs, handouts, brochures
- House-keeping rules keep neat
- Office to Maintain Records/Registers for Contact Tracing (Staff, Trainees, Bus Transfers: Jockey Interns/Passengers)
- Disinfect 2x per day door handles, bus between uses (8.25% bleach)







SIGNS & PPE

- Make signs BIG and prominent incl MOHW signs
- 2. Include COVID19 handouts if possible in waiting areas
- Make COID19

 announcement regularly
 (every 15 mins to 30 mins in between races)
- 4. Plan for ejection rules for disorderly and non-compliant patrons
- 5. Staff policy for mandatory wearing of masks and incorporate mask/breathing breaks
- 6. Staff Policy for age limits, declaring pre-existing conditions, contact tracing, illness, quarantine leave rules, etc













COVID19 Protocols will be Written for the following Groups/Users/Scenarios

Track Operations - Race Day (with Spectators)

- Track Side Operations
- Stables
- Logistics and Movement of Horses/People/Equipment
- Gathering Rooms (e.g. Jockey, Steward)
- Stands (density/capacity), Concessionaires, Lounges
- In-field (Ceremonies, Events)

Medical (Triage) Tent – Race Day

- Triage Questions (Patients referred to Doctor and moved to Isolation Tent when in doubt)
- 2. Grooms' Triage at Vet Office
- 3. Handwash station at entrance with soap dispensers and tissue
- Masks to be worn by ALL Staff and EMTs
- Colour-coded armbands for clearance to enter Race Day
- Antibacterial accessible in Triage area and from Security
- Medical Records sent to First Aid Post
- COVID19 MOHW Flyers and Educational posters
- Staff policy for mandatory wearing of masks and incorporate mask/breathing breaks









Entrance – Staff & Public

- Entrance rules (Staff and Public) to be strictly enforced by Security Team (re-testing, rejection to entrance – no exceptions)
- Masks to be worn by Security
 and Staff/Visitors entering
- 3. Temperature checks mandatory
- 4. Anti-bacterial spray for hands (62-70% alcohol)
- 5. Soap and tissue dispensers nearby or at guard house
- 6. Posters/Signs, PR and advertising, Pre-sold tickets
- 7. Floor signs for Pedestrian queuing to Entrance Gate
- 8. Scenario training incl. handling rejections





Risks BEFORE: Stands – Seated Areas

- 1. Crowding
- 2. Shouting
- 3. Touching
- 4. Railings (surfaces)





Stands – Standing Area

- ALLOWED to congregate in standing areas which have marked as "NO standing" areas and blocked (entrance blocked, taped area off)
- 2. Block access to Standing
 Area and monitor
 movements to ensure
 spectators do not jump
 tape to be in standing area
- 3. Set security policy for breaches (e.g. Removal of non-compliant patron from Stands) and complete training






AFTER: Stands – Seated Areas

- "NO standing" areas marked and blocked
- Alternate seats blocked/marked
- Alternate seating in rows to ensure social distancing
- 4. Patrons can stand at front of their seat
- All Patrons must wear masks while in the stands

 mask breaks can be had outside when >6ft distance from others
- Public Handwash stations with soap and tissue dispensers
- 7. Anti-bacterial dispensers
- 8. Signs
- Training Security on removing non-compliant patrons





RISKS BEFORE: Parade Viewing Balcony

- 1. Crowding
- 2. Touching
- 3. Railing Surfaces
- No hand hygiene (before or after)
- 5. No infection prevention (disinfection)





AFTER: Parade Viewing Balcony

- 1. "No Stopping Here" markings at balcony
- 2. Floor markers (in the event there is no queue)
- 3. All Patrons must wear masks in this area
- 4. Anti-bacterial dispensers or security to spray hands on entering and leaving area
- 5. Signs
- 6. Railings cleaned & disinfected hourly (8.25% bleach)






BEFORE: Stands Open Spaces

- Stopping and Crowding
- 2. Sitting
- 3. Touching
- Cleaning and Disinfection





AFTER: Stands Open Spaces

- Large "NO standing" areas marked and blocked
- 2. No Seating
- 3. All Patrons must wear masks
- 4. Public Handwash stations with soap and tissue dispensers
- 5. Anti-bacterial dispensers
- 6. Signs
- 7. Staircase railings and bathroom cleaned & disinfected hourly (8.25% bleach)





North Lounge

1. No food concession on Day 1 - Prepackaged food and drink can be brought in, immediate disposal after

- 2. "NO standing" areas marked and blocked
- 3. Remove 50% of chairs and space out for physical distancing
- 4. Alternate seating in rows to ensure social distancing
- 5. Patrons can stand at their seat
- 6. All Patrons must wear masks
- 7. Anti-bacterial dispensers Security spraying hands with 62%-70% alcohol and dispensers inside Lounge
- Proper waste management and house-keeping
- 9. Signs at entrance and inside
- 10. Guard with alcohol sprays and temperature check
- 11. Bathroom cleaned & disinfected hourly (8.25% bleach)







Private Boxes

- 1. "NO standing" areas marked and blocked outside of Boxes
- 2. Signs for Physical Distancing inside boxes
- 3. Inside Private boxes (Masks optional)
- 4. Non-guests NOT
 ALLOWED (No
 staff/catering support
 otherwise masks
 mandatory)
- 5. Use bathroom on 3rd floor maintain soap and tissue dispensers
- Anti-bacterial dispensers at each entrance inside Box
- 7. Signs outside and inside Box










Broadcasting & Announcer's Room

- 1. Signs on door and inside
- 2. Staff must wear masks if less than 6 ft and with authorized visitors in box
- 3. Open windows as much as possible
- 4. Non-authorized guests NOT ALLOWED (No staff/catering support otherwise masks mandatory)
- 5. Easy access to bathroom with soap and tissue dispensers Anti-bacterial dispensers at entrance and inside Room
- 6. Disinfection protocol for broadcasting operation/equipment, no sharing of mics, headphones, etc.









Concessionaires/ Drinks


Meals/

No food allowed on Day 1

2. Patrons bring their own food (pre-packaged) and waste management immediate

3. "NO standing" areas marked and blocked and Queue markers in place

- 4. All Patrons must wear masks unless eating and drinking
- Public Handwash stations with soap and tissue dispensers
- 6. Anti-bacterial dispensers
- 7. Waste management
- 8. Signs
- Door handles and trafficked areas cleaned & disinfected hourly (8.25% bleach)















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Cashiers' Windows

- Cashiers to wear shields and masks
- 2. Limit Queues
- No crowding allowed
- 4. Queue Markers on ground "STOP", "WAIT HERE"
- 5. All Patrons must wear masks
- 6. Public wash stations nearby cashier area
- 7. Disinfect cashier surfaces often hourly
- 8. Anti-bacterial dispensers near cashier area
- 9. Security to have alcohol spray bottles
- 10. Signs
- 11. Review cut off times to minimize risk of crowding
- 12. Cashiers' windows disinfected in between each race (8.25% bleach)



Trainers' Lounge

1. Limit to 50% capacity at any time (Capacity: 25 persons)

2. Only Trainers with horses racing on the day allowed

3. Remove 50% of chairs & Domino Table

4. All Patrons must wear masks unless eating and drinking

5. Soap and tissue dispensers in bathrooms

6. Disinfect surfaces often – hourly

7. Limit/No food options - must be prepackaged and waste management immediate

8. Anti-bacterial dispensers – at the entrance and in the room

10. Cashiers - face shields and masks





Saddling Area

- 1. No crowding allowed
- No unauthorized persons
- 3. 3 persons in stall
- 4. ALL PERSONS MUST
 WEAR MASKS at all times
 in Saddling area
- 5. Place public wash stations in saddling area
- Disinfect stalls often in between each saddling session
- 7. Anti-bacterial dispensers in area
- 8. Security to have alcohol spray bottles
- 9. Signs
- Review movement pattern to minimize risk of crowding





Parade Ring

- 1. No crowding allowed
- 2. No unauthorized persons
- 3. 3 persons in stall (excl Jockey)
- 4. ALL PERSONS including Jockeys MUST WEAR MASKS
- 5. Place public wash stations with soap& tissue dispenser in saddling area
- 6. Disinfect stalls often in between each saddling session
- 7. Anti-bacterial dispensers in area
- 8. Security to have alcohol spray bottles
- 9. Signs
- 10.Monitor movement pattern to minimize risk of crowding





Testing Barn (STERILE AREA)

- 1. No crowding allowed
- 2. No unauthorized persons
- 3. ALL PERSONS MUST WEAR MASKS
- 4. Place public wash stations in Barn and Cool Off area
- 5. Disinfect stalls often in between each testing session/use (e.g. Steam) Vet to approve all use of chemicals
- 6. Anti-bacterial dispensers in area/at entrance
- 7. Security to have alcohol spray bottles at entrance
- 8. Review movement pattern to minimize risk of crowding
- 9. Waste management
- 10. Water management
- 11. Signs
- 12. House-keeping Keep neat





Starting Gates & Gate Handlers Rest Area (Sterile Area)

- 1. No unauthorized persons
- Jockeys and Staff MUST WEAR MASKS (train for mask/breathing breaks)
- 3. Jockey mast is options during race
- 4. Place public wash station nearby for after start clean up
- 5. Disinfect stalls often in between each race (8.25% bleach)
- 6. Anti-bacterial dispensers in area, Security to have alcohol spray bottles
- 7. Signs
- Review movement pattern to minimize risk of crowding
- Choose horses wisely for Day 1
